Friends of Art History in Focus – Subscription

After registering, you are able to subscribe. Subscription enables you to benefit from the features outlined in the Friends of Art History in Focus section of the website. These website features will be accessible only upon subscription payment. If you decide to become a Friend, and therefore pay our annual Full Membership fee, you are agreeing to take the annual Full Membership which we make available to you promptly after that fee is paid. However, you may apply for a full refund by emailing to info@arthistoryinfocus.com or by writing to us at PO Box 1509, Woking GU23 6XE within a cooling-off period of 14 working days of receipt of the initial subscription payment or within 14 working days of any renewal (as detailed below). Refunds may only otherwise be given at the discretion of Art History in Focus. The cost of subscription is that advertised and Art History in Focus reserves the right to refuse applications without giving a reason.

Your Full Membership will be automatically renewed at the end of the year and your card will be automatically debited via Paypal. Art History in Focus reserves the right to change the Membership price at short notice as well as the period which it covers, the services which it enables you to obtain and other factors from time to time. However, rest assured that these changes will not affect your then-current Full Membership and you may of course cancel your account when the renewal date is due if you do not accept these changes.

The annual individual membership fee is £89. Couples and Friends living at the same address may benefit from a reduced joint subscription of £149.00.

Notice will be given in advance, via the newsletter, of dates which are scheduled for the **Friends-Only Events**. Friends receive invitations to three complimentary events each year, generally two online and one in person. These events are for Friends of Art History in Focus only, so spaces are limited to one ticket per individual member (or two tickets per joint membership) for each event. Joint members can attend different events if they wish to, if there is a choice. Friends can attend a maximum of three complimentary Friends-Only events per calendar year. Unused places cannot be carried over to the next calendar year.

If a Friend is unable to make any of the annual events on offer, they may transfer the booking to someone else provided that we are given full details in writing and at least 48 hours' notice.

In addition, Friends can also claim **two complimentary lectures from our general online programme to the value of £10 each** per calendar year - please email us at least 1 week in advance of the lecture you wish to attend and we will send you a complimentary pass. Unused places cannot be carried over to the next calendar year and events in excess of £10 are not eligible.

Friends have access to **priority booking** for all Art History in Focus events, including tours and study days. When booking opens, there will be a period in which Friends will have first right of refusal on all spaces – priority booking can be accessed by simply logging into your account online.

Priority spaces are limited to 4 spaces per Friend for all online events (so 8 spaces for joint membership), and 1 space per Friend for all in-person events, tours or holidays (so 2 spaces for joint membership), unless otherwise indicated in the event or tour description. Places are allocated on a first come, first served basis. Please note that due to high demand for tours and events we cannot always guarantee availability so it is advisable to book early.

Friends' names will be automatically entered in a quarterly **prize draw**. Recipients' names and prizes may be mentioned, unless you would prefer to remain anonymous (please advise us if so), in the **Friends' newsletter**.

Friends may also enjoy **advantages** on Art History in Focus tours and in-person events such as, by way of example, free/discounted upgrades if these happen to become available. Please note that this is not a guarantee that such advantages will become available, but if they do so then Friends will be the first to benefit.
