David Davies et al., *El Greco* [exh.cat.], Yale University Press, 2003. A highly authoritative and beautifully illustrated catalogue published in conjunction with the El Greco exhibition organised by the National Gallery, London and the Metropolitan Museum of Art, New York.

More recently many eminent El Greco scholars have contributed to the catalogue of the exhibition held at the Art Institute, Chicago, *El Greco: Ambition and Defiance* (edited by Rebecca J. Long), Yale University Press, 2020. Highly recommended.

Anastasia Drandaki, ed. *The Origins of El Greco: Icon Painting in Venetian Crete* [exh.cat.], Hellenic Museums Shop, 2009.

This exhibition was held at the Alexander S. Onassis Cultural Center in New York City (November 17, 2009-February 27, 2010) and curated by Anastasia Drandaki of the Benaki Museum in Athens. Useful for those wanting to explore el Greco's artistic origins in more depth.
